

HealthLinkBC LOOKING FOR A FAMILY DOCTOR?

The Health Connect Registry is a universal waitlist for all doctors and nurse practitioners in your area; you will be contacted when a provider is available to take you on.

If you live in Campbell River & District (Campbell River, Sayward, Gold River, Tahsis, Quadra Island, Cortes Island) and need a family doctor or nurse practitioner, you can register yourself or your family members for the Health Connect Registry. You can also register on behalf of a person in your care (for example, if you are a health care provider or social worker, you can register a patient).

If you already have a family doctor or nurse practitioner, you don't need to register.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Personal Health Number (PHN), found on your BC Services Card or BC Drivers License
- Home address
- Email address and phone number
